Relationships Australia NT has a new, free support service for seniors who feel unsafe or worried when they have problems with their family, friends or carers.

The new 'Senior Relationship Services' is a pilot service, funded by the Australian Government to 30 June 2022, and is available for people who are 65 years old and over, and Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people who are 50 years old and over. Family members, friends or carers can also contact the service if they are worried about an older person's well-being.

The 'Senior Relationship Services' can help when there is a risk for an older person of:

- being physically or emotionally harmed (for example: being physically hurt, sexually abused or socially isolated)
- not being well cared for (for example: not being fed or other personal care needs not being met; not having a good quality of life)
- being bullied or feeling pressured (for example: about independence, finances or end-of-life arrangements)
- being taken advantage of by others (for example: someone is using money/assets without permission or in a way that doesn't help the older person, or is against their wishes).



The service can assist people before these problems get too big or overwhelming, and can help older people to talk with their family, friends or carers to resolve difficult issues.

Seniors can get information or referrals, speak to a professional counsellor about the problem, or have a professional mediator help with family meetings. Support from experienced Aboriginal staff and/or interpreters services is also available.

New Activities Coordinator for COTA NT


